The term 'conditions for learning' describes the vast array of proven strategies, efforts, programs and approaches that research has shown to improve teaching and learning outcomes.

The coalition fights to make sure that the federal government remains committed to programs that increase the number of K-12 students:

- Who are safe and not victims of bullying or other violence
- Who are mentally and physically healthy
- Who are engaged in school and avoid truancy and dropping out
- Who have strong social and emotional skills
- Who refrain from alcohol, tobacco and other drug use
- Who report caring and supportive relationships with adults in their families, schools and the community

The coalition provides outreach and education to Congress, develops and advocates for improved public policies and serves as a convener for partner organizations to share information and network.
